This document outlines the procedures for creating an IEEE-compliant PDF using PDF eXpress, preparing a camera-ready manuscript, and submitting IEEE copyright forms.

1 IEEE-Xplore-compatible PDF generation

Create an IEEE PDF eXpress account and enter the following information:

- Conference ID :**60790X**
- Your email address
- A password


On the "**IEEE PDF eXpress® Dashboard: 60790X**" page, you have the option to select "**CREATE NEW FILE**". This action initiates a dialog prompt requesting the title of your paper, followed by the paper upload step. Upon completion, the system will display the outcomes as either '**Pass**' or '**Fail**'. Subsequently, the successfully converted PDF file can be approved directly from this page, allowing for its download. This downloaded file is then ready for submission to the Conference Management Toolkit (CMT).

2 Camera-Ready Submission

Step-1:


First login to the Microsoft CMT website with your Email and Password:

Step-2:

Within the Microsoft CMT Author Console, select your role as "**Author**" from the top right corner, then click on the "**Create Camera Ready**" link, highlighted in a red rectangle for easy identification.



On the "**Create New Camera Ready Submission**" page, input the title, abstract, and the details for all authors. Following this, upload the IEEE PDF eXpress-approved PDF file of your paper. After reviewing, agree to the terms by checking the "I agree" checkbox, then click "**SUBMIT**" to proceed.

3 IEEE copyright transfer form submission

From the Author Console in CMT, click on “Submit IEEE Copyright Form”.
